

CCCC DAO Local 2021 Meeting script, 8/8/19

[call to order] I call to order this public meeting of the community centered cooperative committee, local number 2021 decentralized autonomous organization, I, Ombudsman Antarah A. Crawley, presiding. Today is August 8, 2019, and we are located in the Chinatown Coffee Company in the City of Washington, DC. This is the first session of the committee on strategic development and social practice; and there is a quorum of members assembled.

Item 1. Opening Remarks

Greetings and thanks to the members assembled. Again, my name is Antarah Crawley, and I am an independent community ombudsman. The ombudsman is a civil service provider whose title means representative of the people. In my general practice of Ombudsman I gather information on community intelligence, draft and publish reports on such matters, and represent these findings to the community members assembled.

Toward this end the Vice Chair, Alayna Holland, and I have convened this committee of the community members, wherein you people, the member of the community, have assembled in committee to hear and to speak truly regarding the matters of interest and concern to our community.

Now, a few remarks upon the governance and organizational structure of the committee:

This committee is convened on the authority of the people, and by no other entity but the people. Any and all community members may assemble in committee on the basis of their own free will, and all members thereby consent to follow the prescribed procedures which are adopted for the sake of the committee's

order. There is no ruler over this body; and the chair and vice chair receive their jurisdiction only by and through the consensus of the members assembled. The role of these officers is only to bring order to the committee's proceedings. In this way our organization is decentralized and automated by nature

Any two persons with the basic social and administrative competency may convene a committee as chair and vice chair. Therefore the organization as a whole shall have no central ruler, except by and through any given assembly of the people.

How then shall such meetings proceed in order without central rulership, you might ask? I, the chair have adopted a procedural code, a program, used for running committees of this kind, and that code is developed by the New Syllabus research and development organization. All such code used in the running of proceedings are and shall be distributed open source through the Public Register located at newsyllabus.org/infoSystems or any other similar registry or database. Such distribution of code allows for consistent procedures and programs to run autonomously and independently across the decentralized network of committees.

Furthermore, any community member can move to amend the code, or adopt their own operating system in the running of other committees.

For these reasons ours is a decentralized and autonomous organization, or DAO. In other words, ours is an organic grassroots organizational model for the people; it is an incorporeal entity, meaning that it is a non-incorporated entity that is constituted solely by the assembly of its individual members and which does not otherwise have any legal existence. I will now read the abstract of the white paper on General Practice [which can be found on the Public Register], which describes the overall approach to social practice in the DAO. Please contemplate and meditate upon these words as we proceed through our meeting.
