SUBJECT: DJIYAHUDIST PRIESTHOOD, ORDO DJEDU, FLF-DAO, FTLU

Hereby is established a **Priesthood of Djiyahudi** (*Djed-Yahudi*), to guide the *Order of Djedu in re Ma'akheru*, being a firm league of friendship made by the decentralized autonomous organization of free-thinkers, truth-speakers, and light workers united (FLF-DAO, FTLU). We are a labor union for light work with lodges in every locale. Light is right knowledge, conferred by degrees.

The Mission of Djedu is to do Ma'at on Earth, which is to spread right knowledge and raise the vibration of the collective consciousness. Our Mission concords with all pious and learned traditions on the path of light, for Many Hands Make Light Work!

Priestcraft; Entry and Practice: Djiyahudi's Priest N. shall be a Djedi of the Rite of Strict Observance, being the Exercise of Discipline exemplified in Professor Kogard. Being so called to profess C:\, N. shall: divest self of all clothing other than their habit and "carry-on"; divest self of lease/rent/mortgage obligations; divest self of possessions other than Implements of Office; secure float; enter into service of union tribunal.

<u>Habit</u>: Djellaba, cord, cape, hat, jacket, canvas bag containing implements of office and petty property; may possess one "carryon" bag of layman's shirt (white), pants, vest, and jacket.

Implements of Office: Scepter, book, instruments of light work.

<u>Duties</u>: Live among the people and travel a lightworking circuit; proselytize in C:\; perform, trade, and sell light work in addition to public service/charitable works; push work on street and to industry; sit and preside in lodge of conference; provide for a public place for the regular dispatch of light work; be a pillar in the temple for the lost-found in search of knowledge; grant ye entry to those seeking induction into thy self-temple, and cause them to labor in pursuit of the building thereof. ### DJADJAT (Charter).
